**1st Annual QISD QHS-FHS Homecoming Celebration** - This will be the first year for a full-fledged week of homecoming festivities. The 73<sup>rd</sup> Annual QISD Fall Festival has been re-scheduled to be held on this same day. The 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Homecoming Parade was created in the fall of 2008 with astounding success and support from our communities. This year's Saturday events will begin with the BBQ cook-off and parade set-up leading to the actual parade and judging of the cook-off followed by the Education Foundation selling plate lunches. The FHS cheerleaders will begin taking registrants for the Alum Flag-football game at 1:00 pm followed by meeting behind the Multi-purpose facility for alum tug-of-war games. The flag-football game will be held at 3:00 pm on the practice field at FHS and will be followed by the annual Fall Festival and ending with our first annual Homecoming street dance at the FHS baseball field at 7 pm. Every activity after the parade will take place at Ford High School.

This year's celebration is set to start a school and community tradition. The BBQ cook-off is for alum and hometown folk to come together for a contest to be judged by the Mayor's of Quinlan, West Tawakoni, Hawk Cove and Union Valley along with the QISD board president. This is a hometown event meant to be fun and carry bragging rights from year to year on who has the best in BBQ meat, sauce or beans.

### **BRING LAWN CHAIRS TO FHS FOR AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES – HOMECOMING T-SHIRTS WILL BE ON SALE**

The Parade is also meant to be family oriented and loads of fun. After the parade ends, be sure to continue celebrations back at FHS as the Education Foundation will be selling BBQ plate lunches and sponsoring a cook-off with judging from 12 noon – 1 pm.

Registration for the Alum football game will begin at 1:00 PM followed by Tug-of-War games among various groups. The pre-Alum football ceremony will take place on the practice fields behind the Multi-purpose facility at 2:30 with the game beginning at 3:00 PM. The Alum game and dance will be \$3 to attend both and must keep tickets or \$2 to attend one event at the gate.

The 73<sup>rd</sup> annual QISD Fall Festival will take place after the games back in the FHS parking lot. All groups are encouraged to purchase booths from the FHS FFA. Booths are \$25 for school groups and \$35 for non-school groups.

The First Annual QISD Homecoming Street Dance is set to take place in the FHS baseball field – Entry fee will be \$3 and includes admission to afternoon alum game or \$2 if just attending the street dance with no alum game/street dance pre-sale ticket. The Street Dance will feature '90 alum Tommy Joe Wilson from Nashville among several other alum artists. See ya at the dance!
