Important Information

- Charcoal, wood or wood-pellet grills only – NO GAS
- The entry fee is \$10 per category (payments can be made the day of the event if prior arrangement has been made!) – ALL PROCEEDS BENEFIT THE QISD EDUCATION FOUNDATION
- Set-up time Saturday morning will begin at 6:00 am at FHS on the WEST edge of the FHS parking lot in designated area. (area closest to Multi-purpose facility)
- Entries should be set-up no later than 9:00 am.
- Judging will take place between 12 noon and 1 pm and 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place trophies will be awarded at 1:30 pm by mayoral judges from Quinlan, West Tawakoni, Hawk Cove and Union Valley and the QISD Board President.
- No electricity will be available but generators are welcome!
- **In order for any participant to sell samples to the public, you must obtain a temporary health permit. You may do so by calling 903-408-4140 and speaking with Jamie Hibbs. Permits are \$50. There will be an opportunity to sell samples to the public on Saturday from 12 noon – 3:00 pm. No drinks are to be sold as the Foundation will be selling water and soda. (Bring 1's and 5's if you plan to sell samples!**
- The Foundation will be selling BBQ plate lunches to the public from 12 noon to 3:00 pm
- No alcohol or tobacco of any kind are allowed on school property.

1st Annual QISD QHS-FHS Homecoming Celebration - This will be the first year for a full-fledged homecoming week of festivities. The 73rd Annual QISD Fall Festival has been re-scheduled to be held on this same day. The 1st Annual Homecoming Parade was created in the fall of 2008 with astounding success and support from the community. This year's Saturday events will begin with the BBQ cook-off and parade set-up leading to the actual parade and judging of the cook-off followed by the Education Foundation selling plate lunches. The FHS cheerleaders will begin taking registrants for the Alum Flag-football game at 1:00 pm followed by meeting behind the Multi-purpose facility for alum tug-of-war games. The flag-football game will be held at 3:00 pm on the practice field at FHS and will be followed by the annual Fall Festival and ending with our first annual Homecoming street dance. Every activity after the parade will take place at Ford High School. This year's celebration is set to start a school and community tradition. The BBQ cook-off is for alum and hometown folk to come together for a contest to be judged by local city and school leaders. This is a hometown event meant to be fun and carry bragging rights from year to year on who has the best in BBQ meat, sauce or beans.

After the parade ends, be sure to continue celebrations back at FHS as the Education Foundation will be selling BBQ plate lunches and sponsoring a cook-off with judging from 12 noon – 1 pm. Plates will be sold till they run out or 3:00 pm when the Alum game begins. All groups are encouraged to purchase booths from the FHS FFA for the 73rd Annual QISD Fall Festival. Booths are \$25 for school groups and \$35 for non-school groups. The First Annual QISD Homecoming Street Dance is set to take place in the coach parking area in front of the Multi-purpose facility at 7:00 PM. The alum game and dance will be \$3 and tickets will be handed out. If attending the dance alone, it is \$2 at the gate. We look forward to having a day full of school and community spirit. Thank you for your support of Quinlan schools.
